Who is eligible/cost?

In compliance with New School policy, **all** degree, diploma, online only, visiting, mobility (study abroad), Lang and Parsons consortium, graduate certificate program, and both graduate and undergraduate degree program non-matriculating students are **automatically charged** a Student Health Services Fee as well as a Student Accident and Sickness Insurance Plan Fee.

What are the Waiver Deadline Dates?

If you have comparable insurance coverage you may waive the Student Accident and Sickness Insurance Plan by completing the **Online Waiver Form** by the following **Waiver Deadline Dates**:

Fall Deadline: September 29, 2008

Spring Deadline: February 23, 2009

Failure to waive coverage by the deadline date will result in the student remaining enrolled in the Insurance Plan and being responsible for the applicable fees. Detailed instructions on how to complete the Online Waiver Form are provided on the reverse side of this flyer.

What is covered?

How do I waive the Student Accident and Sickness Insurance Plan?

You are eligible to waive the New School Student Accident and Sickness Insurance Plan if you have determined that your personal health insurance is comparable to the university's Plan and that you will be insured throughout the entire 2008-2009 Academic Year. **Waivers will only be accepted if completed online by the posted Waiver Deadline Date.**

To waive the New School Student Accident and Sickness Insurance Plan, please visit www.universityhealthplans.com and select the "New School" link. You will be prompted to provide your personal health insurance information through this link. When you have successfully completed the online waiver process you will receive a confirmation email, including your waiver reference number. We suggest that you print out your confirmation email and retain it for your records.
