# Am I Eligible?

#### **International Students**

## **Plan Benefits**

UNLESS OTHERWISE SPECIFIED BELOW THE MEDICAL PLAN DEDUCTIBLE (IF APPLICABLE) WILL ALWAYS APPLY.

When You receive Emergency Services, or Out-of-Network air Ambulance Services, or certain non-emergency Treatment by an Out-of-Network Provider at an In-Network Hospital or Ambulatory Surgical Center, You are protected from Surprise Billing. In these situations, Your cost sharing responsibility will be calculated as if the total amount that would be charged for the services by an In-Network Provider or facility were equal to the Recognized Amount for the services, which is generally defined either as an amount set by state law or the lesser of the billed charges and the Qualifying Payment Amount. #### **Pre-Certification Requirement:**

- 8. Complex Imaging;
- 9. Biomarker Testing
- 10. Chemotherapy/Radiation or Proton Therapy;
- 11. Cochlear devices;
- 12. Fertility Preservation;
- 13. Infusions/Injectables;
- 14. Botox Injections;
- 15. Genetic Testing, except for BRCA;
- 16. Orthotics/Prosthetics;
- 17. Non-emergency air Ambulance (fixed wing);
- 18. Outpatient Private Duty Nursing.
