Vision Benefit

The WFU Student Health Insurance plan insured by BCBS NC includes vision benefits for enrolled members.

Vision Benefits

- One routine comprehensive eye exam per benefit period is covered at no cost innetwork only.
- Adult lenses, frames, or contacts are <u>reimbursable to the student</u> for up to \$200 for prescribed eyeglasses, hard, soft, or disposable contact lenses

Finding a Provider:

Locate an in-network provider <u>HERE</u>. Eye exam benefits are available from in-network providers only.

At Your Visit:

Tell your in-network provider that you have an annual eye exam covered under your medical plan and provide your BCBS NC ID card. The eye doctor should submit your in-network claim to BCBS of NC.

If you are purchasing eyeglasses or contacts, you will need to pay the full cost of the glasses or contacts. After your visit you can submit for reimbursement of the up to \$200 benefit for materials.

After Your Visit:

Your in-network provider will bill BCBS NC for your **eye exam only**. You can track the status of your claim and view your Explanation of Benefits (EOB) via your Blue Connect Portal

If you purchased glasses or contacts, you can submit your claim for up to \$200 reimbursement per policy year via your <u>Blue Connect Portal</u>.
